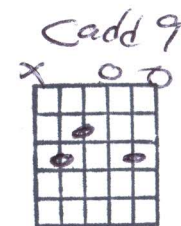
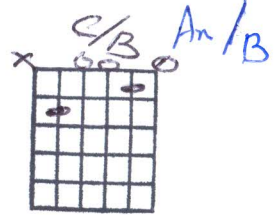
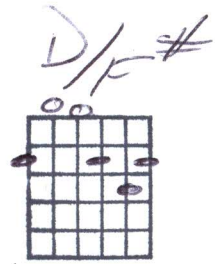
Dear Mr President, come take a walk with me
