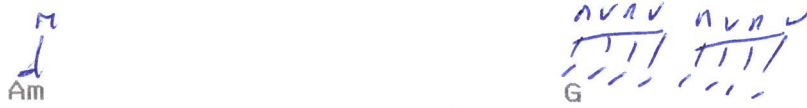
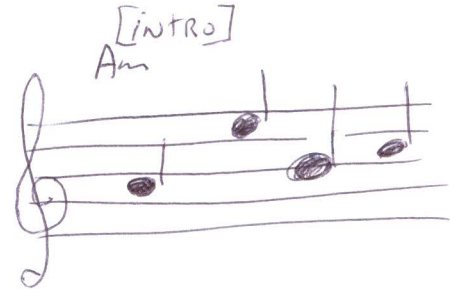
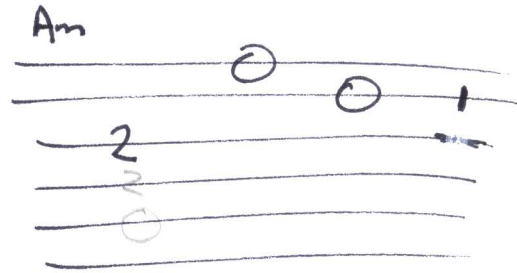


# THE SOUND OF SILENCE
