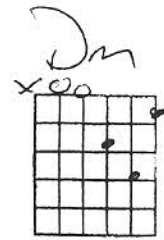
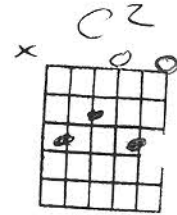


You Can Sleep While I Drive

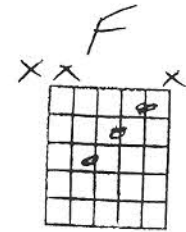
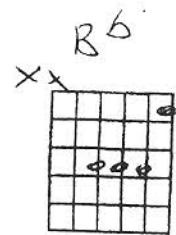
| Dm | C(2) |
